The Club will:

Players will:

- Listen to coaches when they are talking
- Do your best and never give up
- Come to training wearing the correct equipment (e.g. boots, shin pads, clothing)
- Have fun when playing
- Respect the training facilities, clubhouse and grounds
- Help collect balls, cones, bibs during and after training
- Be positive towards your teammates and always support them
- Respect other players, opposition teams, and spectators at all times
- Respect the match officials at all times
- Support the team, match officials, opposition team players/coaches and spectators in a manner consistent with The FA Respect programme

Parents/Guardians will:

- Ensure your child arrives at the correct time and venue for training/matches
- Give advance notice of player unavailability for training/matches where possible
- Ensure any items that a player is not allowed to wear on the field of play are removed before attending training/matches (e.g. jewellery)
- Ensure that your child is wearing the correct kit on match days
- Raise any concerns you have directly to the coaches as soon as possible
- Ensure that any concerns raised to you by the coaches about your child, e.g. behavioural, are discussed with your child and dealt with in an appropriate way
- Ensure that subs payments are made according to the relevant payment schedule

- Support club fundraising activities where possible
- Ensure player kit is looked after and regularly washed
- Ensure that your child is not left unaccompanied at training/matches without first notifying the coach in attendance
- Respect other players, opposition teams, and spectators at all times
- Respect the match officials at all times
- Support the team, match officials, opposition team players/coaches and spectators in a manner consistent with The FA Respect programme
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Team coaches will:

- Ensure parents/guardians are notified in advance of dates/times/venues of training and matches
- Ensure that competitive game time is distributed in a fair and equitable way balancing player development and team achievement
- Ensure that training sessions are appropriate according to the ability of each player
- Operate a yellow (warning) and red (player is removed from session) card system at training/matches to deal with inappropriate behaviour
- Reserve the right to not select a player for a match if the player is consistently poorly behaved
- Respect other players, opposition teams, and spectators at all times
- Respect the match officials at all times
- Intervene in, and challenge abusive and/or disrespectful behaviour (including toward match officials), taking appropriate action if this occurs, including reporting incidents to the appropriate authorities, and/or removing players from the field of play until the issue is resolved. If players are removed from the field of play during a game and the issue cannot subsequently be resolved satisfactorily, the coach will advise the match official(s) that their team will not return to the field of play, even if this causes the game to be abandoned.
- Ensure DBS, Safeguarding, and First Aid qualifications are kept up to date.
- Immediately raise any Safeguarding issues to the Club Child Welfare Officer.
- Support the team, match officials, opposition team players/coaches and spectators in a manner consistent with The FA Respect programme
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At individual coaches' discretion, coaches may record game stats and make them available for parents/guardians to view. FA rules regarding publishing of game results/league tables for U11 and below will be respected.
